

Exhibit A: VIR Rules and Regulations

Gate Hours - The main gate is generally open either 24 hours or from 7:00 a.m. - 7:00 p.m. unless other advance arrangements are made. No one will be permitted access to the facility 30 minutes prior to the gate closing to ensure that VIR staff can lock up at the appointed closing time. If the Premises are not vacated by the time required by this contract, the Renter will be subject to a fine of \$150 per 15 minutes that it is late in vacating the facility.

Trailer Drops - Trailer drops on the day prior to your rental MAY be provided as a courtesy, at the track's discretion. Trailer drops are typically allowed from 5:30-6:30 p.m., but there are occasions when this is not possible, due to the day's rental. It is your responsibility to inform your participants of these restrictions. They will not be admitted if they arrive early.

Speed Limits - Speed limit in the paddock is 15 mph. Speed limit on access roads is 25 mph. Do not test vehicles or bed brakes on infield roads.

Lodging – Renter shall publicize VIR on-site lodging and the VIR Buck rewards program in all of its printed materials related to the event to its Participants. VIR will provide, upon Renter's request, promotional materials for VIR Bucks, VIR Lodging, the paddock garages, go-karting, hospitality and the Oak Tree Tavern.

Asphalt - Do not pound stakes or make any holes in any asphalt surface. Do not paint any asphalt surface. Offenders will be held liable for all damages and may be ejected. Do not paddock on paved areas. Do not fuel cars on paved areas, except as permitted on pit road during racing competition. Any fuel spills on pit road must be immediately diluted with Cold Fire. If you must temporarily jack a vehicle on asphalt, you must have metal or wood under the jack and jack stands. NO EXCEPTIONS!

Disposal of Waste Fluid and Environmental Debris - Use of the waste drums is mandatory for used oil, antifreeze, brake fluid, and other polluting material. Spillage will not be tolerated and may result in ejection from the facility. Participants must remove all used tires, batteries and unwanted parts. Environmental debris left behind will result in fines to the Participant or to the Renter renting the facility.

Fences- Do not climb fences or enter areas behind spectator fences without obtaining permission from VIR security or emergency personnel.

Showers - The showers are located in the North Paddock Main concession building restrooms, at the North Paddock grid barn, just outside the North Paddock entrance, and the South Paddock tech shed. Please be considerate regarding water use. Please do not waste water in any way.

Camping - Participants may camp at VIR only if the camper (motor home, tent or trailer occupant) pays VIR a camper's fee of \$35 per weekend per tent or \$50 per weekend per RV. Those participants not camping but using electricity will be charged \$25. Further, camping will be allowed during private event evenings only if Renter pays VIR for overnight security. The amount of security needed for overnight camping is at VIR's discretion. Camping in any of VIR's buildings is forbidden. A Group Camping rate can possibly be arranged if requested in advance by Renter at VIR's discretion.

Power - There is limited electrical power available. Participants who have paid for camping will not be charged for the use of power. VIR personnel will collect \$25 from participants for power use per Event.

Cars & Motorcycles – No one under 16 years of age may operate a car or motorcycle anywhere on VIR premises, without VIR's prior written approval. In addition, anyone operating a car or motorcycle must

have a valid operator's license and liability insurance, as required by Virginia law. There may be special exceptions to this rule for licensed racers and the renter must notify VIR should it seek such an exception.

Off Road Vehicle Policy: ATVs, golf carts, and other off road vehicles must be licensed by VIR upon payment by the owner of a \$25 fee per event or \$100 per season. Track renters can obtain a license at no charge for its vehicles. Only licensed drivers can operate these vehicles at VIR. Children must not operate these vehicles at VIR. VIR maintains an impound area for unlicensed off road vehicles. Off road vehicles must be operated in accord with VIR's off road vehicle policy.

Bicycles: Children under 16 are prohibited from riding bikes, roller blades, skates, skateboards, and scooters in the paddock during hot track hours. Children may be permitted to ride them at the end of the day if they do so safely.

Noise - Unmuffled engines must not be run between 8:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m. There is a quiet hour on Sundays from 11:00 am until 12:00 noon. The location and operation of any dynos or similar equipment are subject to track approval.

Fireworks - Fireworks are prohibited anywhere on the grounds.

Alcohol - Beer and wine are available for sale at our concession stands. Beer in coolers is permitted for individual consumption.

Food Service - VIR has an exclusive caterer(s). If you would like to arrange food or beverage service, it must be with a VIR approved exclusive caterer. Hospitality tents must also be rented through VIR. Please contact group sales at 434-822-7700 x115 to arrange catering. Only individual food service may be self-catered, and any self-catering of corporate events is prohibited unless arranged in advance and a self-catering fee is paid.

Children: Children under 18 years of age must be closely supervised by a responsible adult.

Pets - VIR discourages bringing pets to the track. Pets will be allowed if they are leashed and if you clean up after them. Otherwise, VIR will find the owner and both will be asked to leave. Do not take leashed pets onto false grid or pit areas. Pets are also not allowed in any of VIR's buildings or the concession area.

Music- Please do not play loud music; be considerate of neighbors.

Pit Wall - Standing on pit wall or applying tape to it is prohibited.

Campfires - Campfires/Ground fires are not allowed.

Track Closed - The racecourse is closed from 5:30pm to 8:30am to motorized traffic.

Smoking: Smoking in VIR's buildings is strictly forbidden and will not be tolerated. Please place all extinguished cigarettes in the receptacles provided.

Off Road Areas: The off road areas within VIR (including but not limited to rally stages behind and next to the go kart track and trails below the South Paddock) must not be utilized by participants without prior written approval of VIR. Vehicular traffic on grass around the track will be limited to necessary traffic. Vehicles will not be driven on the grass around the race track proper unless absolutely necessary and will not be parked at corner stations.

Patriot Course: When Patriot Course is in use in conjunction with the Full Course, it must run clockwise.

False Grid and Pavilion: Cars may not be worked on or parked under the False Grid in the North Paddock or in the Pavilion outside the North Paddock.

Shipments: Renter is responsible for shipments by its participants to VIR. Large shipments should be arranged with the office in advance and are subject to a minimum handling charge of \$5. Larger shipments (for example, crated engines) are subject to a greater handling charge at VIR's discretion.
